A1 Dishforth to Leeming Improvement

Stone deliveries to the Project during 2010 & 2011

We have programmed the construction work to enable us complete the A1M from Dishforth to Leeming in the shortest possible timescale with the least disruption to the local population. In order to achieve this we need to bring stone from local quarries and, to meet the programme, deliveries of this stone will increase in the 2010 summer months and to a lesser extent during summer 2011.

The quantities of stone required for the whole project are immense and whilst we are reusing and recycling as much material as possible from the site we still need to import some 2 million tonnes of stone from other sources.

We will be using 5 quarries to supply this material but the majority of stone will be delivered from Leyburn Quarry and from Gebdykes Quarry (South of Bedale). We have made every effort to minimise disruption by routing the deliveries through less populated areas avoiding the major townships of Leyburn and Bedale.

The busiest months will be between May and October with a total of 550 heavy goods vehicle deliveries per day. This compares to last autumn when 550 heavy goods vehicle deliveries was undertaken in the month of October. However you can rest assured HGV movements will be strictly controlled to ensure disturbance and disruption to local communities is minimised.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused by the essential deliveries to the project.

Details of the routes that will be used and the measures taken to minimise the number of journeys needed are available from the main project site office at Leases bridge.
